

## **Email Roadmap**

The UBC Faculty & Staff E-mail (FASmail) service is a UBC-funded and in-house hosted enterprise e-mail service for staff, faculty and student employees of the University of British Columbia.

FASmail will support 15K to 20K users. Current technology consists of Exchange 2010 application servers and data stores running on a virtual environment that offers High Availability (HA) and enterprise capabilities. Database Availability Group (DAG) will be implemented to add HA at the application level. Incremental increase in user mailbox storage as well Archiving will be a big consideration in the next 3 years. The service will deploy the next version upgrade of Exchange after the release of service pack 1.
